This new log home design is inspired by the Canadian Qu'Appelle River, which flows 267 miles (or 430 kilometers) from Lake Diefenbaker in southwestern Saskatchewan to the Assiniboine River in Manitoba.

The two-bedroom, two-bath cabin incorporates high-tech environmental features, including a patent-pending Log Lock Compression System that ratchets logs tighter together. The cabin design has an open kitchen that flows into the sitting and living areas to maximize space. There is an attached

deck off of the living area that is perfect for entertaining guests.

The large, first-floor master bedroom features a bump out with a relaxing spa and shower area so you can spoil yourself a bit at your getaway.

The upper level features a large loft that can be used for extra sleeping space. It is connected by a catwalk leading out to a second floor deck that can capture a great view from a well-sited cabin. The second bedroom and bath are also on the upper level. The plan truly showcases and harmonizes with its natural surroundings.
